Lesson Two

Jesus Takes Away Sin!

Luke 18:31-43; Mark 10:46-52

1. Why were Jesus and His disciples going to Jerusalem?

2. Who was sitting by the roadside begging?

3. What big event happened in the city that day?

4. What did Bartimaeus call out to Jesus?

5. What are some ways children are spiritually blind today?

6. Why do you think Bartimaeus was so persistent even when people told him to be quiet?

7. How did Jesus show he loved Bartimaeus?

8. What happened after Jesus worked the miracle?

9. Why is it important to praise God for the gift of salvation?

10. What is God saying to you through this passage?

Lesson Three

Only Jesus Satisfies!

John 6:1-14, 22-25, 66-71; Mark 6:30-44

1. Why was the large crowd following Jesus?
2. What question did Jesus ask Philip? Why did he ask that question (v. 6)?
3. What was Philip's response?
4. What solution did Andrew find?
5. What were Jesus' directions to the disciples?
6. After Jesus blessed the food, what happened?
7. Why did the people follow Jesus the next day?
8. In what ways might children try to fill their spiritual hunger with things other than Jesus?
9. What did you learn about who Jesus is from this passage?
10. How does Jesus satisfy your spiritual needs?

Lesson Four

Jesus Has All Power!

John 11:1-46

1. Who became very ill? What was his relationship to Jesus?

2. What was the purpose of this illness according to Jesus?

3. Why did the disciples try to discourage Jesus from going to Judea?

4. What did Jesus mean by “I go to awaken him”?

5. What response did Jesus want to see from the disciples as a result of Lazarus’s death?

6. How long had Lazarus been dead before Jesus arrived?

7. Briefly describe Jesus’ conversation with Martha.

8. Why do you think Jesus wept at Lazarus’ tomb?

9. What did Jesus pray right before the miracle?

10. How does Jesus being the resurrection and the life give hope to the children you will teach?

Lesson Five

Jesus desires Faith!

John 4:46-53

1. What is faith?

2. Who came to Jesus and why?

3. What was Jesus' rebuke to the people who were listening? (The "you" is plural, indicating a crowd.)

4. What was the official asking for?

5. What was Jesus' response?

6. How did the official show his faith?

7. When did the son begin to improve?

8. Who believed in Jesus as a result?

9. How can saved children live by faith each day?

10. What is God saying to you through this passage?
